Many of the home lots in The Glens of Connemara border golf course property, parkland, cul-de-sacs, or Ludwig's Farm, providing homeowners scenic views, safety, and privacy.

"We're getting interest from all types of residents, all of them attracted to Castletown's reputation for building a quality home, the value we consistently provide, and the character of Lemont," Bell said.

The Glens of Connemara is quickly accessible by Route 83, Interstate 55, or a pair of I-355 exits (127th Street or Archer Avenue) located on 131st Street just west of Bell Road.
